Type – **RAIN**



On March 21, 2022, the Texas Division of Emergency Management activated Texas A&M Task Force 1 as a Type 3 Wide Area Search Team in anticipation of severe weather across the state of Texas. Texas Task Force 2 was also activated as a Type 3 Wide Area Search Team along with 4 Swiftwater Rescue Squads, a Water Group Supervisor, and Support Specialists. As the tornado threat increased, TDEM changed TX-TF 1 from a Type 3 to a Type 1 team to allow for additional resources.

On March 21, 2022, TX-TF 2 searched a mobile home park for tornado survivors just north of Gordonville, TX. The team coordinated one assist, 11 evacuations, multiple welfare checks, and 100 damage assessments.

Once the storm had passed, on March 22, 2022, TDEM demobilized all resources back to their home stations.
