On December 24, 2024, Texas Task Force 2 (TX-TF2) was activated to assist the City of Sherman Fire and Rescue Department in locating a juvenile that was swept away after a one vehicle accident and ended up in a fast-moving creek in Grayson County. Over the following days the team completed targeted searches with the Human Remains (HR) canines and reconnaissance of debris piles.

On December 27, 2024, unknown remains were detected by the canines, so contact was made with the Texas Division of Emergency Management, Dallas Co. OEM, and Sherman Police Department to recruit a forensic expert for identification. Photos of the unidentified remains were sent to two forensic experts and along with further investigation of the scene, it was determine that the remains were animal. The team continued searching the next day after being joined by additional HR canine resources.

On the morning of December 29, 2024, the team received demobilization orders from the State Operations Center and all TX-TF2 personnel returned to their home stations.
